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Official Rules & Guidelines

To participate in Stompfest, Panhellenic organizations must meet certain criteria and agree to the guidelines provided below. Please be cognizant of these rules because you will be representing your organization, as well as, NPHC and the entire Greek community.



The performance should last 8-10 minutes. If your performance goes over 10 minutes, it will result in point loss.



Only performing members of the CPC organizations are allowed on stage. No members from the audience or outside organizations are allowed to assist your performance.



Members of NPHC cannot be on stage during the performance.



There can be no more than 25 participants on stage at a time, but the step team can have up to 100 people.



The usage of vulgar hand gestures and offensive language is prohibited. This also includes speaking poorly of other organizations in your routine. If done, it may result in disqualification.



The musical selections must be edited. Music must be submitted on a USB on **Monday, April 15, 2019** to the NPHC advisor, Sade A. Dawson in Koldus 224 by 5 p.m.



All scoring will be made by the judges. Final decisions will be at their discretion.



Failure to attend assigned practices with your NPHC organization may result in the loss of dress rehearsal privileges or point deduction.



All props used during the performance must be approved by the Stompfest Committee.



NO glitter, NO food or drinks, NO noisemakers, NO types of oil, and NO fire or pyro effects (things that may be messy) are allowed on stage. This is a requirement of the auditorium- *see document attached to the application.*
